Example of an annotated bibliography entry: Writing an Annotation. An annotated bibliography is composed of the full APA reference for a source followed by notes and commentary about that source. The word "annotate" means "critical or explanatory notes" and the word "bibliography" means "a list of sources".

An annotated bibliography is a type of student paper in which reference list entries are followed by short descriptions of the work, called annotations. Annotated bibliographies can also constitute one element of a research paper in fields that require bibliographies rather than reference lists.

The bibliographic information : Generally, though, the bibliographic information of the source (the title, author, publisher, date, etc.) is written in either MLA or APA format.

In 1991, the Government of Canada ratified the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child, requiring governments at all levels to ensure that Canadian laws and practices safeguard the rights of children. *A Question of Commitment: Children's Rights in Canada* is the first book to assess the extent to which Canada has fulfilled this commitment. The editors, R.
